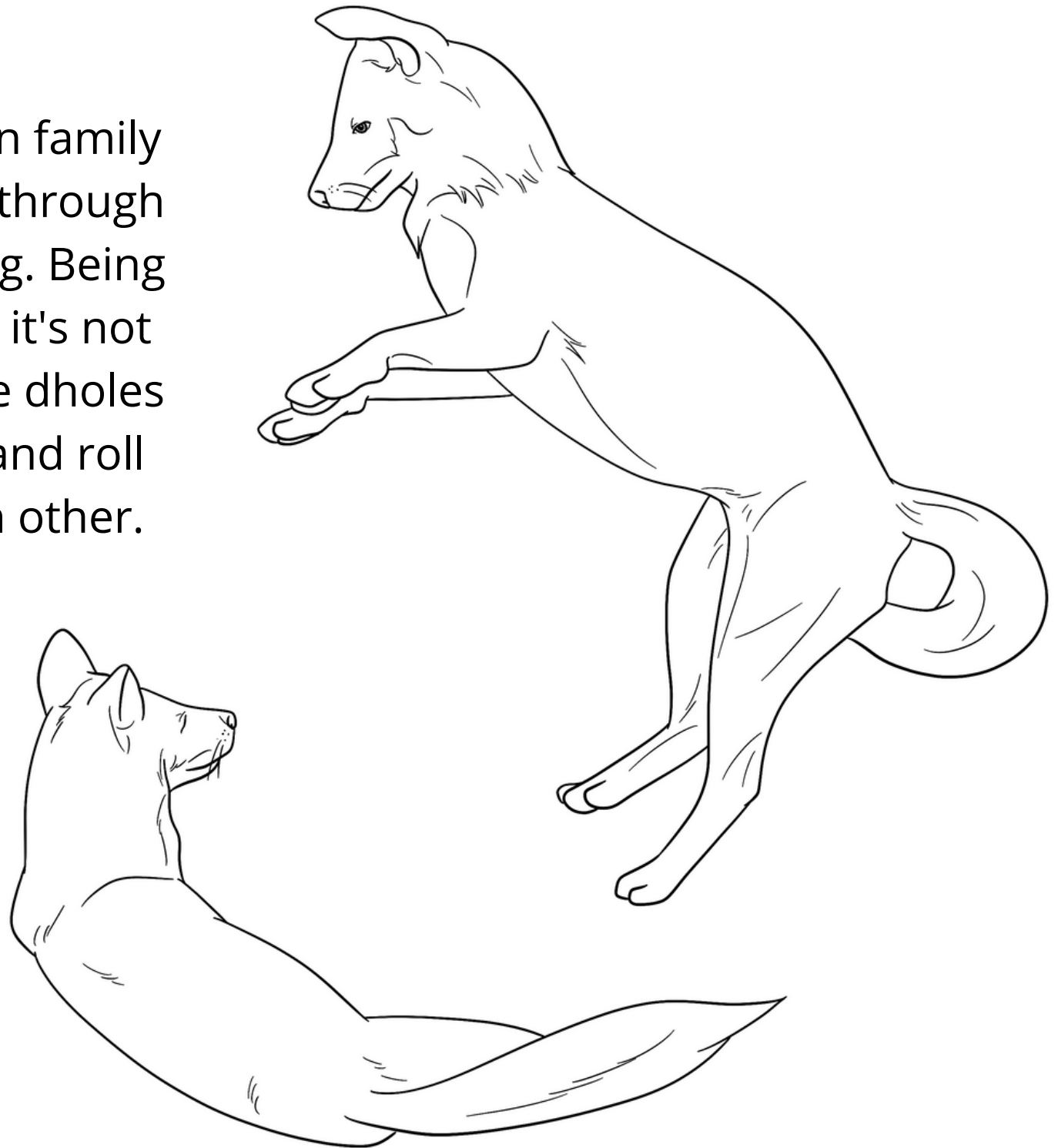


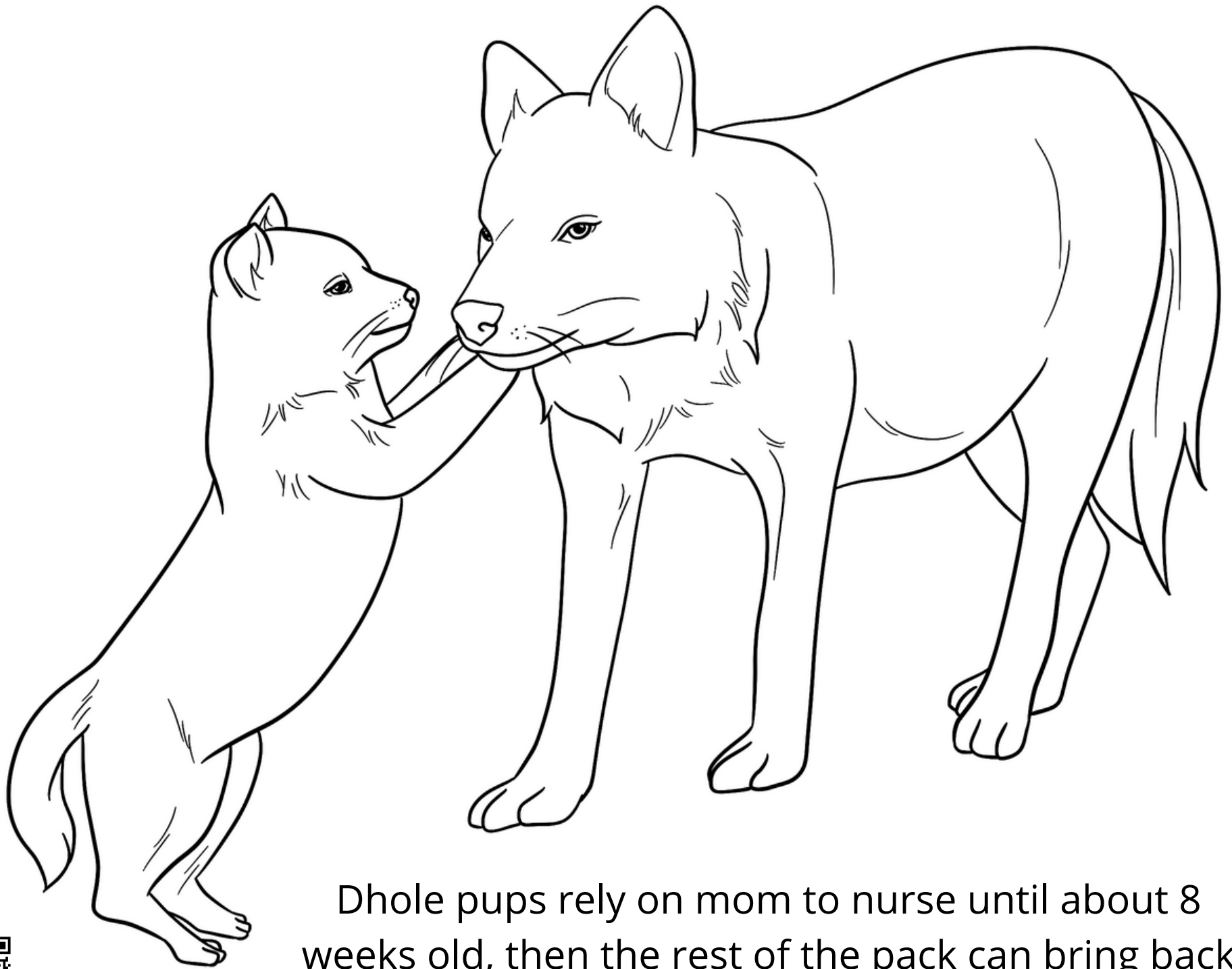


Dholes are crepuscular, meaning they are most active at dawn and dusk



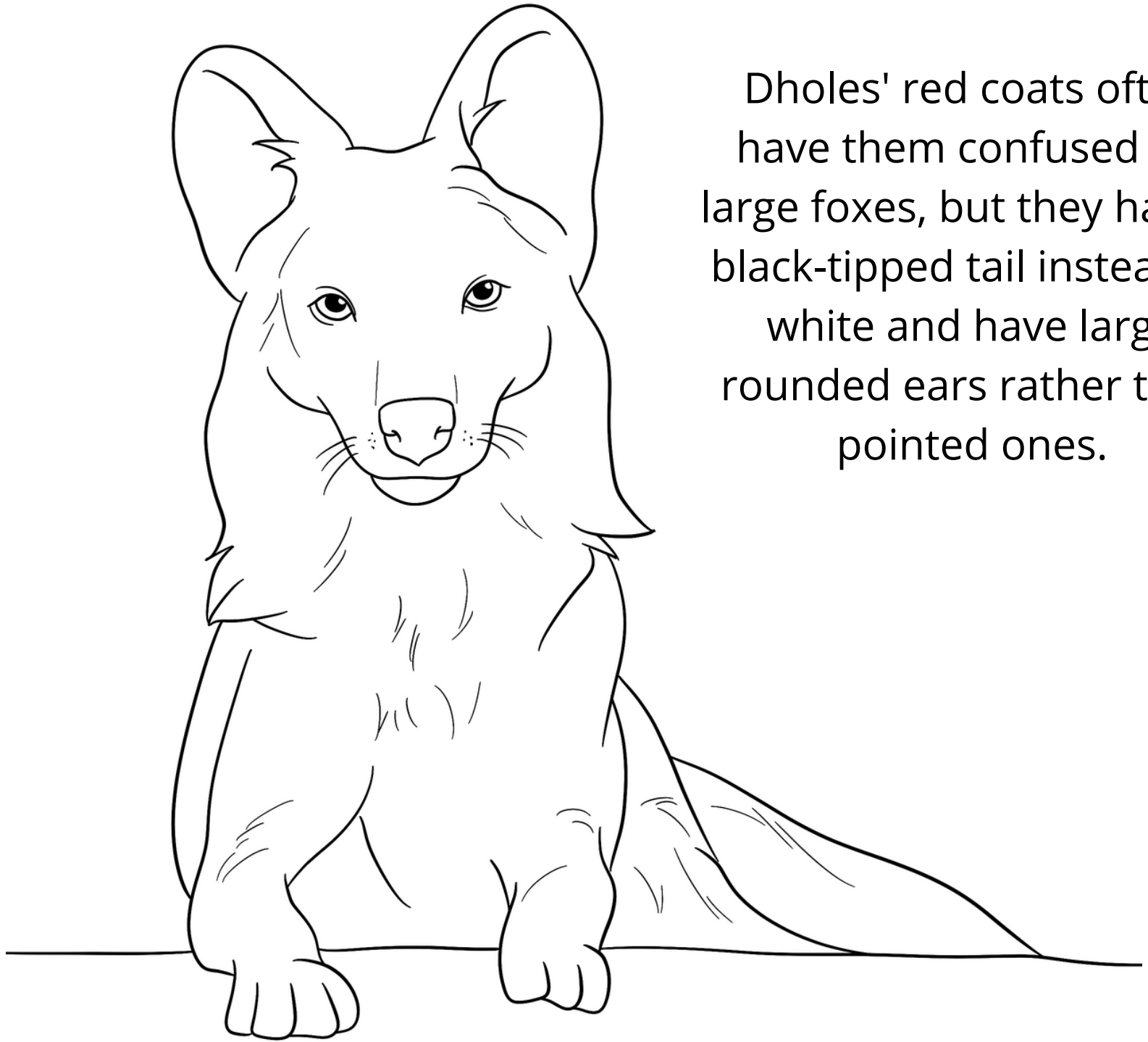
Dholes strengthen family and social bonds through play and grooming. Being good at jumping, it's not uncommon to see dholes bounce around and roll around with each other.





Dhole pups rely on mom to nurse until about 8 weeks old, then the rest of the pack can bring back meat for the pups to eat.





Dholes' red coats often have them confused for large foxes, but they have a black-tipped tail instead of white and have large rounded ears rather than pointed ones.
